



Waqf Properties be registered for Welfare

Hon'ble Union Minister for Minority Affairs Dr. Najma A. Heptullah on Thursday, January 22, 2015 said that the property belonging to Muslim Sunni and Shia Waqf Boards in the country will be registered and developed to fund minority welfare activities. "Six Lakh Acres of Waqf Property is spread all over India. If we develop them according to the Sachchar Committee Report they will provide anywhere between Rs.20,000 Crores and Rs.25,000 Crores per annum. This money can be used for the welfare and upliftment of Muslims in the Country," Dr. Heptullah said in Patna. She added that to make this happen, Waqf Boards in the country will be reconstituted and the properties belonging to them will be registered to facilitate their digitization. Linkages with "Aadhaar" Numbers will also be provided to bring in transparency in the activities. "Some people may feel bad about these measures, but they are for the benefit of the Muslims. Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has entrusted me to oversee the implementation. Our officers have started discussing it with Waqf Boards. They are doing it in Patna today," Dr. Heptullah said. Hon'ble Union Minister was speaking at a function at the Bihar Bharatiya Janata Party headquarters in Patna, while talking about various schemes initiated by the Centre for the welfare of six categories of minorities: Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jains and Parsis.

Expressing anguish over the "backward" condition of the minorities, especially Muslims in Bihar, Dr. Heptullah said central funds for scholarships, education of girls, multi-sectoral skill development are being sent, but the State has failed in utilizing them.

"It is a sad thing that less than 50 per cent of money that we sent has been spent on various minority welfare schemes and when we inspect on the ground level, we find mismatch and huge gaps in the expenditure and reality," she said.

Hon'ble Union Minister added that all data regarding funds sent, expenditure and ground reality, will be made available on-line to bring in transparency and show the exact status of the welfare schemes.

She said the Hon'ble Prime Minister wants "**Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas**" (i.e., all inclusive development) and the aim of the Union Ministry of Minority Affairs is to usher in financial, economic development among the poor peoples in the minority communities.
