Vikas Samanvay Baithak for Northern States held in Lucknow on January 18, 2018

“Vikas Samanvay Baithak” (i.e., Development Coordination Conference) of 9 Northern States and Union Territories organized in Uttar Pradesh at Lucknow on January 18, 2018 to brainstorm the themes such as “Empowerment without Appeasement” and “Development with Dignity” of all sections of the society with emphasis on various Schemes being run by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India.

This Baithak was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, presided by Hon'ble Union Minister for Minority Affairs and Co-chaired by Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Minority Affairs. Besides Minority Affairs Ministers, Social Welfare Ministers, concerned Secretaries and other Senior Officers from Punjab, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Chandigarh, Uttarakhand, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir and Haryana have attended this Baithak and actively participated in the wide ranging discussions.



While speaking on the occasion, the Hon'ble Union Minister for Minority Affairs, Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi said that the Government led by our Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, is working with commitment to “Inclusive Growth”, which has ensured that all sections of the society including Minorities, are becoming an equal partners in the development process. “The Government has ensured that benefits of welfare schemes reach the needy directly through a transparent system”, he further added. He emphasized that the Minority Affairs Ministry has completely become online/digital. He added that the Ministry of Minority Affairs is working with commitment to welfare of Minorities through “3E - Education, Employment, Empowerment”. He further added that most of the States and Union Territories have been working well in implementing the Schemes meant for Minorities.



Speaking on the occasion, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Minority Affairs, Dr. Virendra Kumar said that the youth has a crucial role to play in the field of development. He added that the Baithak will provide a good platform to share experiences among participating States and Union Territories. Such Baithaks are planned to be organized in Kolkata and Mumbai in the coming months.
