4th Steering Committee Meeting of Waqf Computerization Scheme held on May 18, 2015



The 4th meeting of Steering Committee of the “Scheme of Computerization of the records of State Waqf Boards” was held on May 18, 2015 at 11:00 A.M. under the Chairpersonship of Shri Rakesh Mohan, Joint Secretary (Waqf) in the Conference Hall “Chintan”, 11th Floor, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003 to review the progress of the Scheme.

Chairman reviewed the Action Taken Report of the decisions taken during the 3rd Steering Committee Meeting held on July 09, 2013. Chairman informed the members that Central Waqf Council (CWC) has been entrusted with the remaining work of data entry & scanning of documents for Registration Module of WAMSI On-line System and WAMSI-DMS System under the Phase-I of the Scheme after getting Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between CWC and the Ministry in the month of December 2013.

Secretary (CWC) informed the members that NSIC has been hired for the job and Waqf Board specific Work Orders are being issued to NSIC. Secretary (CWC) further apprised the committee about the proposal which has been submitted to the Ministry for deployment of One IT Systems Manager & One Data Management Assistant on contractual basis from an Outsourced Agency in order to implement and to continue the operations of WAMSI Software Systems at the level of State/UT Waqf Board. He informed that this Outsourced Agency will be hired by CWC through Open Tendering following GFR-2005.

Chairman clarified that the Ministry of Minority Affairs has never asked the Waqf Boards to stop the computerization work because of non-releasing of Handholding Charges from October 2013 due to slow progress of data ingestion. Since this computerization work is in the interest of Waqf Boards, so they should continue without ifs & buts. It was felt that a clarification letter from the Ministry is required to be sent to all Waqf Boards in this regard urgently.

While reviewing the WAMSI On-line System Modules’ data entry, the Committee clarified that data entry is mandatory now in respect of leasing of all such Waqf Properties where lease period is beyond One Year, irrespective of whether they are under direct management or not, due to new provision in the Wakf (Amendments) Act, 2013 which says that sanction of Waqf Board is required for all such leases. So, relevant changes are required in the WAMSI On-line System’s Leasing Module.

The Committee felt the need of issuing the guidelines immediately to Waqf Boards for GIS Mapping of Waqf Properties for the usage of funds released under Strengthening of State/UT Waqf Boards Scheme recently in-order to share GPS Coordinates & Photographs of the Immovable Waqf Properties vis-a-vis unique WaqfIDs & PropertyIDs of WAMSI On-line System for generating GIS Reports from it.

The committee also decided to hold regular meeting of Steering and Management Committee in different zones of the country to ascertain and review the progress of the computerization work. It was further decided to hold the next meeting of the Steering Committee in the last week of August 2015.
