Hon'ble Union MoS joined



Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi has assumed the office as a Minister of State for Minority Affairs on November 11, 2014. Interacting with media Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi said that security and prosperity are of utmost importance to the minorities. He will prefer working in close association with people to eliminate middlemen and ensuring that benefits of various schemes reach the desired target. He will strive to instill among minorities, the feeling of being participants and stakeholders in the process of development of the country by protecting them from falling prey to the feeling of alienation.

A National Conference of Chairpersons and Chief Executive Officers of State Waqf Boards was held on November 13, 2014 at ICC, New Delhi to deliberate on the implementation of The Waqf (Amendments) Act, 2013. **Hon'ble Union Minister Dr. Najma A. Heptulla** while chairing the conference spoke about the importance of Computerization of Waqf Boards and appreciated the progress made by large numbers of State Waqf Boards in uploading the basic inventory data about the Waqf Properties in WAMSI On-line System. She said this is not the end, peoples also wanted to know the Mutawalli, Income Generated, Welfare Measures Taken, Status of Litigation (if any) of each Waqf Property through Public Interface of WAMSI On-line System. Therefore, State Waqf Boards needs to enter up-to-date data on these aspects and immediately update whenever events impacting their state occurs. She said our next target would be to locate these Waqf Properties on GIS Maps using latest GPS Technology. This will help in protecting the Waqf Properties from encroachment, alienation and illegal transfers. When a large number of persons knows about the Waqf Properties then they will automatically help in protecting such Waqf Properties. Moreover, they will also suggest ways & means to augment the Revenue Generation for running Welfare Programmes as per the intentions of Waqif.

Hon'ble Union Minister of State Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi while co-chairing the Conference said he specifically wanted to know from the State Waqf Boards whether the earlier hurdles faced by them is overcome by the new & modified provisions enacted in The Waqf (Amendments) Act, 2013 or not and what are the new challenges in protecting the Waqf Properties. It may be noted that he was an active well-researched member in the Select Committee of Rajya Sabha for considering the amendments proposed in the Waqf Act, 1995. He provided the valuable inputs during the deliberations.
