### Features/Modifications

**\* Report Card of each Waqf Property:** Report Card of each Waqf Property is being introduced which will be carrying all the information of that particular Waqf Property on the given time such as complete details of Registration, Survey, Management, Annual Return Filing and Leasing & Litigation (if any). It will also have historical details like all the Managements, All Annual Returns, Incomes & Expenditures Graphs, All the Leases and All Litigation Cases including closed cases be Internal or External.

**\* GPS Coordinates Entry Form:** New GPS Coordinates Entry Form is being developed for defining the contours of Waqf Properties on the Earth. Earlier single central GPS Coordinates were recorded to know the position.

**\* Editing of Management Details:** Editing of Management Details, as per the feedbacks from SWBs, is being carried-out that will give more leverage to State Waqf Boards for editing.
