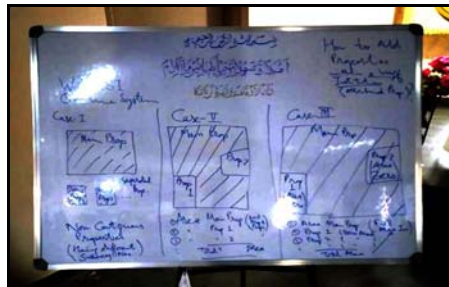

Karnataka State Board of Auqaf is planning GPS Survey & Photography in a big way

Shri Mohammad Mohsin, IAS, Secretary (Backward Classes & Minority Welfare) -cum- Administrator (KSBA), Government of Karnataka had reviewed the implementation of WAMSI On-line System in Karnataka State on Wednesday, October 25, 2017 at Bangaluru in presence of Shri Naeem Ahmed, Senior Technical Director & National WAMSI Project Coordinator, National Informatics Centre (HQ), New Delhi and Shri S. M. Zulfiquarulla, CEO & other Officers of Karnataka State Board of Auqaf (KSBA). Wide ranging discussion took place as a follow-up of a detailed presentation made by Shri Ahmed on WAMSI On-line System implementation at KSBA. Two representatives of Karnataka State Remote Sensing Applications Centre were also invited in the meeting. All the participants appreciated GIS Integration as well as Encroachment Detection Methodology in WAMSI On-line System. Developments (or Encroachments) were highlighted through GIS on a Karnataka Waqf Property having WAMSI-ID as KA030239-0T001 with the help of Historical Satellite Imageries of various time intervals. At the end, Hon'ble Administrator decided to implement the WAMSI On-line System in to-to at the earliest including GPS Survey & Photography. He requested Shri Ahmed to prepare an Action Plan with Targets and Timelines which will be incorporated in the Minutes of the Meeting, for further necessary action at the level of Karnataka State Board of Auqaf at an earliest to catch-up with the progress of other State Waqf Boards.



Karnataka State Board of Auqaf also organized an "on-the-field Hands-on-Training" for GPS Survey & Photography of their Waqf Properties using WAMSI Data Catch v1.1 Mobile App for all Districts Survey Officers (Waqf) on Thursday, October 26, 2017 at The Muslim Orphanage Office, Bangaluru. So, that Districts Survey Officers (Waqf) could conduct GPS Survey & Photography of Waqf Properties in their assigned Districts on their own, in order to accomplish systematic & accurate GIS Mapping. A full day Classroom Training along with on-the-field Hands-on-Training was conducted by Shri Naeem Ahmed, who was especially invited by the Karnataka State Board of Auqaf for two-days programmes at Bangaluru.



Shri Tanveer Sait, Hon'ble Minister for Primary & Secondary Education, Minority Welfare & Auqaf, Government of Karnataka, graced the occasion and delivered an impressive speech in the afternoon to highlight the importance of GIS Mapping of Waqf Properties for their protection. He emphasized an immediate need of GIS Mapping using latest Information & Communication Technologies' Tools before it is too late and easy prey for encroachers. He calls upon everyone to work towards it, so that we could leave Waqf Properties intact for next generations to come. If protected they could generate maximum revenue to turn welfare programmes & schemes for under privilege sections of the society.
